GSSA PRESIDENT

The Council Meeting of May 31st was the last of the current term. In keeping with the By-Laws of the Society the members of the next Council will be announced at the AGM on July 17th and will meet for the first time on Saturday July 26th.

Council is responsible for the management of the affairs of the Society although day-to-day operational activities are delegated to a Management Committee (Manco). That said membership of Council is a commitment to the Society and all members of Council are expected to attend at least half of the six meetings held each year.

Nominations for the next Council are now open, and members are encouraged to avail themselves of this opportunity to serve the Society. Membership of Council is restricted to Corporate Members and Fellows of the Society of not less than three year's standing and whose fees are not in arrears. The term of office is one year although standing members can be nominated for additional terms.

Other important administrative news is that the project to replace our legacy WordPress website with a modern, custom-built web platform is close to completion. The new platform emphasises simplicity, consistent design, usability, and enhanced functionality while moving critical business processes to the cloud.

On May 30th Craig Smith and I held an online meeting with the leadership of the student branch at the University of Venda. The branch is led by Mr Mashudu Matsa, who chairs a committee of ten members studying towards a Bachelor of Earth Science in either Mining and Environmental Geology or Hydrology and Water Resources although there are also additional members on the committee studying Bachelor of Environmental Sciences. Following the meeting, the GSSA sent a Letter of Recognition to the branch which we hope will facilitate access to resources at the University and thereby assist the branch with field trips and on campus meetings.

The LOC for GeoCongress2025 held a final planning meeting on May 23rd, and all is on track for what we anticipate will be a successful meeting next month. Based on the abstracts accepted, there will be 180 oral papers presented in 4 parallel sessions supported by poster sessions on both Wednesday and Thursday. Delegate numbers are expected to be close to 300 including a group of 39 students sponsored from the REI Fund.

In preparation for the AGM on July 17th, members of the Management Committee and Chairs of Branches and Divisions have been hard at work compiling their contributions to the 125th Annual Report. Deadline for contributions is May 31st, after which the Annual Report will be compiled by Lully Govender from the GSSA Office and distributed electronically to Corporate Members and Fellows in good standing.

SAJG Alert

The March issue of the South African Journal of Geology (128–1) has been sent to our Technical Editor, Mike Knoper, for online publication in June. The issue has 114 pages and contains 5 original, peer-reviewed, papers. Special issues of the SAJG with papers related to the Merensky Reef 100 meeting in August 2024 and updates on selected chapters of The Geology of South Africa are progressing well.


