DRAFT GEOSCIENCE ACT, REGULATIONS 2020

In early March, the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE) gazetted proposed Regulations to the Geoscience Act, requesting comment by April 19. The proposed regulations impact many geoscience stakeholders, and the GSSA has submitted comment, as it routinely does for proposed legislation that may affect the earth science community. # Fostering a safer workplace for Geoscientists held on 24 March 2021



The GSSA/WiMSA webinar on Fostering a Safer workplace for Geoscientists attracted delegates from all over the world and in all fields of practice. Some of our speakers have provided more resources as a follow up on the event. Diana Schwartz Attorneys offer various trainings in terms of GBVH. The GBV, Sexual Harassment, Femicide & The law Training is specifically legal compliance training. The Brave Workshop is an Employee Wellness & Legal collaboration with an employee wellness and relationship expert. ### Some of the feedback from the survey that accompanied the webinar :

- More than 50% of victims work in consulting/contracting/service providing, followed by exploration, office/corporate, surface mining, and underground mining.
- Of the participants, 68% identify as a woman, 27% identify as a man, and 5% identify both.
- More than 50% of survey participants have experienced sexual harassment more than once, while 11% say it is ongoing.
- 73% of the victims were 30 years of age and younger when they experienced sexual harassment.
- 7% of participants left the mining industry after having been sexually harassed.
