





Recent trends in mining and exploration are set to further accelerate the demand and growth of 3D geological modelling software. These trends include the inevitable increase in cost per ton of resource and global economic slowdowns. These require companies to constantly cost-cut during extraction and to improve resource delineation. Add to this the trend that new discoveries are deeper and in more structurally-complex setting, and it's apparent that a great deal of attention needs to be focused on getting the geometry of a deposit, as early as possible in the exploration and mining value chain, correct.

# PROFESSIONALISM AND CODE OF ETHICS

Free Online Course

11 OCTOBER 2022

The term "ethical behaviour" is applied to a person's conduct in professional matters and is judged in comparison to the standards of the profession, which are formally expressed in statements called codes of ethics. Codes of ethics are the value guidelines that a professional must follow in order to remain registered as a member of the profession.

Ethical conduct, or professional decision-making, is a necessary requisite to being called a professional. A professional must be able to properly balance competing values in making decisions that affect both society and the client.

This online course by Dr Tania Marshall provides an understanding of what you need to be a professional in the mining industry.

ioGAS™ is an exploratory data analysis software application developed specifically for the resources industry to detect patterns, anomalies and relationships in geoscience data. Live links have been developed between ioGAS and other geoscience/GIS software programmes (such as Leapfrog, QGIS, Mira Geoscience, Discover, acQuire, Micromine, ArcGIS and Minalayze)

The GSSA and Imdex have partnered to present a half-day (4 hours) of training on the ioGAS Fundamentals Module. This course focuses on the skills necessary to start importing and interpreting your geoscience data using the ioGAS software. It covers topics such as data validation/QC tools, univariate and multivariate plots, downhole and line plots to interrogate your drillhole data, geospatial plots, the creation and use of classification diagrams and calculations, and an overview of how to move your data interpretation seamlessly into other GIS and geology modelling packages.


