Continuous Professional Development (“CPD”) is a term used to describe learning activities that professionals take part in to develop and enhance their skills, thereby expanding and improving their knowledge. It is the systematic maintenance, improvement and broadening of knowledge and skills, and the development of personal qualities necessary for execution of professional and technical duties throughout the individual’s working life. It refers to the process of tracking and documenting the skills, knowledge and experience that an individual gains, both formally and informally, beyond any initial training. This may include courses, workshops, informal learning opportunities, or vocational education that helps to expand knowledge or add new skills related to a chosen career.
